Theatre Arts

In Theatre Arts students will study all aspects of theatre including; acting, writing, directing and technical theatre. Each semester students will do at least one production for the public. Past productions include; <u>All My Sons</u>, <u>The Diary of Anne Frank</u>, <u>Almost Maine</u>, and <u>The Doctor in Spite of Himself</u>. We also produce student written one act plays. Theatre Arts students have gone on to Cornell, NYU, Ithaca, UVM and many others.

Stagecraft/ Drama & Theatre (Course #3210): Stagecraft is a hands-on class where you will learn carpentry skills while building and painting sets for theatre productions. You will also have the opportunity to design sets for the theatre. You will learn how to create lighting for plays as well. This is a good class for people interested in building trades, theatre or video.
