Lawler at 9:18AM. First order of business was to elect a chair. E. Edelson was nominated by D. Whitman and J. Johnson. With no other nominations, and unanimous vote, Edelson was elected chair. He expressed his great honor and love for this committee and accepted the charge. There was no public in attendance, so the committee went right to work reviewing and discussing the new policies required by the state. All schools have been directed to develop policies concerning Fire and Emergency Preparedness Drills and Access Control and Visitor Management. L. Johnson shared that we usually follow the same policy format as SVSU and we number the policies accordingly. J. Lamson explained the policy setup as prepared and made suggestions as to numbering and wording. He noted there will be administrative regs added to assist in defining each policy. If we keep to the state suggested format, warning and adoption should be relatively simple. Due to deadlines required by the state to set these policies in motion, we may need to have a special meeting before the next scheduled one. J. Lamson will take the committee's suggestions and along with required language continue to work on the necessary policies as soon as possible. We have a system in place already for monitoring visitors and guests, so it will be fine-tuned to state requirements. Campus safety development is ongoing and will also be updated to state requirements. As we are two separate schools, (MAU and SWT), sharing some combined space, there must be mutual agreement in areas of safety. Policy 2200C-Anti-Discrimination was briefly discussed for language and specific placement of this language. J. Lamson will adjust as suggested. Committee adjourned at 9:55AM to attend full board meeting. Committee expects to hear from J. Lamson in the near future and will meet before the August full board meeting.
