19	Lamb called the meeting to order at 5:30 and noted that the only item on the Agenda for this
20	Special Meeting was discussion and action on the Human Resources / Superintendent
21	Services Contract. Lamb then turned the meeting over to Montgomery and Lewis for their
22 23	presentation.
24	Montgomery reported that last week he made a proposal to the Finance Committee that
25	CDC assumes Menu of Services, currently provided by SVSU in-house. This proposal is
26	based on 1) efficiency and 2) cost.
27 28	Montgomery then turned the Board's attention to two handouts, #1 Menu of Services
28 29	provided by the SVSU To SVRTSD and #2 the SW VT Technical School District
30	Organizational Chart, which shows the proposed inclusion of SVSU services for 2009/ 2010.
31	organizational origin, which chows the proposed moldostrol evec convices for 2000/2010.
32	Discussion followed, with the following topics highlighted:
33	
34	Johnson inquired as to when and by whom was the proposal initiated.
35	It was noted that it has been discussed for several years, more recently the proposal
36	has been discussed at two Finance Committee meetings and by the full Board at the
37	Readsboro meeting. Lewis further noted that Pembroke has indicated that because of
38	the differences between CDC's and SVSU's software, the cost for services would be
39	more.
40	laborate inquired as to east decompositation
41	Johnson inquired as to cost documentation.
42	Lewis reported that there was discussion with SVSU and CDC does not yet have SVSU's figures. Also discussed were the Unifund cost, Contingency Fund, and
43 44	additional costs. Lamb clarified that when talking about the \$38,000 savings that would
45	be incurred by bring HR Services in-house, it should be noted that the software has
46	already been purchased with this year's budget. This savings has been built into the
47	upcoming budget.

Johnson Inquired about Legal Services, which have been included with SVSU's services.

Lewis reported that he has always budgeted for Special Services although there has not been a significant need in the past 8-9 years. Johnson wants all to 'understand and be prepared for the risks if you are out on your own'.

Letourneau noted that NEASC, in their last Report of Accreditation, said that the CDC needs to become 100% of its own Supervisory Union, and NEASC speaks with the voice of Board of Education. Johnson voiced that NEASC does not require HR Services to be done inhouse; he would feel better if the services were contracted out and that administration concentrate on education rather than on these services.

Montgomery reiterated efficiency and cost. Bob believes strongly that it can be done very well in-house; CDC is a small organization with 35 people. There has been in depth discussion and planning with the administrative staff, leading to the proposed Organizational Chart (handout 2). The other two tech centers, River Valley and Hannaford, both handle the services in-house.

Harrington noted that there have been issues with SVSU and by bringing the services inhouse we will be investing in the future. Rickey extended his thanks to administration for being willing to take on the additional work without a pay increase. He also noted that accountability would be in-house.

Kinney voiced that he found it hard to believe that we were looking to 'go out on our own' rather than consolidated. He feels that this would create an unneeded bureaucracy. Fran had additional questions regarding the superintendent. Lamb replied that he did attend several meetings with the other tech centers. They, like CDC, are by law their own supervisory unions and have done what CDC is proposing to do tonight.

Harrington moved and Letourneau seconded the motion that we will perform the HR and Superintendent services that we now contract and become our own supervisory school district starting July 1, 2009. Hand vote was taken with DeLucia, Kinney, and Johnson voting nay. The motion carried.

At 6:00 PM Corcoran moved and Alexander seconded a motion to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
